★★	An improvement to one star rating and verging on a valuable source of either pollen and/or nectar, but not regarded as sufficient overall value to purposely transport apiaries onto these flowering events.
★★★	Of reasonable value as a source of either pollen and/or nectar.
★★★★	Plants in this group have an abundance of either pollen and/or nectar that is readily gathered by honey bees.
★★★★★	In most circumstances plants in this group will be sought out by commercial beekeepers for their value as either a source of pollen and/or nectar.
