## **Pollinator Rating**

- Of some value to honeybees for either pollen and/or nectar but regarded as incidental. Unlikely to be of sufficient overall value to purposely transport apiaries onto these flowering events.
- Verging on a valuable source of either pollen and/or nectar, but not regarded as sufficient overall value to purposely transport apiaries onto these flowering events.
- Of reasonable value as a source of either pollen and/or nectar for honeybees. From time to time plants in this group are very useful to commercial beekeeping purposes.
- Plants in this group have an abundance of either pollen and/or nectar that is readily gathered by honeybees. These plants will be sought after by commercial beekeeping interests.
- ••••• In most circumstances plants in this group will be highly sought out by commercial beekeepers for their value as either a source of pollen and/or nectar.
